RETURNING AN ADOPTED ANIMAL TO BAM'S CARE

It is BAM's policy to take any previously adopted pet that had been deemed disruptive out of an adoptive home and back into foster or adoption center care when possible.

When a pet is disrupted and must move from their adoptive placement, the Foster Care Coordinator and the previous foster parent or adoption center contact must be notified.

RETURNING AN ANIMAL TO BAM WITHIN THREE (3) MONTHS OF ADOPTION

Any animal that has been in its adoptive home for three (3) months or less will be taken back into care as soon as space is available, provided the animal has not bitten anyone or shown any aggression toward a person since being adopted.

If applicable, an animal returning from adoption will be placed in its previous foster home whenever possible. This provides the least amount of disruption to the animal. Pets having been adopted directly from That BAM Place will be welcomed back into care as space permits. The foster network will be asked for placement within a home if all kennel spaces are filled.

If the animal is returned within two (2) weeks of its placement in an adoptive home, one half (1/2) of the adoption donation will be returned.

RETURNING AN ANIMAL TO BAM AFTER THREE (3) MONTHS OF ADOPTION

If the adoptive owner is still considered appropriate per current adoption/fostering requirements, BAM will encourage them to act as a foster for the animal until such time as one of BAM's approved foster homes can be located, there is a vacancy in the Foster Program or in the adoption center at That BAM Place, or until the animal is placed in another adoptive home.

If the adoptive owner is unable to foster and space is not available, they may place the animal with another rescue group or in a designated no-kill shelter or, upon approval from the President of BAM, locate another home for the animal themselves.

The BAM Foster Care Coordinator and previous foster parent shall make every effort to assist in locating a suitable placement for said animal.

RETURNING AN ANIMAL TO BAM AFTER SIX (6) MONTHS OF ADOPTION

Any animal being returned to foster care after six (6) months will be viewed as an animal new to BAM and subject to review, temperament testing, availability of a foster home or space at , and a \$50 relinquishment fee.
